Walk through the Bible

Walk through the Bible continues to be an effective program as we are pleased to report the completion of five 1 hour sessions covering the Old and five 1 hour sessions covering the New Testament.

Chris, Wendy Slavin and Adam Broughton led the sessions in Kirkcaldy North Primary School.

Mrs Campbell with the Primary 5/6 explored the Old Testament (OT MINI) where they learnt Keywords and Hand Signs to help them remember the stories.

Throughout the sessions the children were participating in dramas, quizzes, songs, videos and a multi-media presentation alongside their own Work Maps helping them grasp the BIG picture of the Old Testament.

Having already completed OT MINI earlier in 2019 the Primary 7's with Mr Cobain explored the New Testament (NT MINI) with 40 different Keywords and Hand Signs.



Both classes were excellent in their participation which made the sessions entertaining and memorable. The teachers commented that the children were always happy to be going along to the classes, they were engaged and mentioned that a number of the pupils had been practising the hand signs in class!

Both members of staff agreed it had been a positive experience, as the sessions used various types of teaching methods it was so 'animated' (including the presenters!) with one pupil being heard to say, 'this is my favourite thing that we do in school right now'
